Angela Smith is a native Texan and award winning writer and working musician. Executive Director Emeritus of the Writers' League of Texas, Smith is now a full-time freelancer. When she's not writing, editing or gigging as a pan player, cellist or pianist, you can find her gazing through a 22-inch telescope she keeps in a dome in New Mexico. Angela Smith is a member of the Zonta Club of Austin.

Angela's book *Steel Drums and Steelbands: A History* is a vivid account of the events that led to the "accidental" invention of the steel drum: the only acoustic musical instrument invented in the 20th century.



Kaleta Doolin is a writer and artist dedicated to exploring and interpreting the creative process through book arts, sculpture, and cutting-edge technologies applied to photography and video installation. She lives in Dallas and is a member of the Zonta Club of Dallas.

Kaleta is the daughter of the Frito Company's founder and she has written an insider's look at the company in *Fritos Pie: Stories, Recipes, and More*. The book is filled with personal anecdotes, more than 150 vintage and newly created recipes, and stories. This book recounts the company's early days, the 1961 merger that created Frito-Lay, Inc., and beyond.



Jim Sanderson has previously published about sixty short stories, essays, or scholarly articles. He teaches fiction writing, American literature and film at Lamar University and currently serves as the Writing Director within the English Department. Sanderson's short story collection, *Faded Love* was a finalist for the 2010 Texas Institute of Letters' Jesse Jones Award for best book-length fiction by a Texas writer or about Texas. In 2011 Sanderson's Dolph Martinez/Jerri Johnson detective series, *Dolph's Team* was published by Ink Brush Press.

Jim Sanderson was born in San Antonio. Much of his work is set in Texas, particularly West Texas and border.
